

## **FISH STOCKING – 2010** **Minden/Haliburton**



Our annual fish-stocking program this year resulted in a total of 77,850 fish being placed in local water bodies. The majority were stocked using a specially equipped Ministry helicopter. This gets the job done much faster than road stocking and also allows us to place fish into more suitable habitats within the lakes.

Once again, the Haliburton Highlands Outdoors Association, through their hatchery, raised and stocked 18,600 Lake Trout & 19,150 Rainbow Trout into local lakes. The many dedicated volunteers who were involved in the raising of these fish also assisted the MNR in their distribution, which was greatly appreciated.

One way you can assist us as an angler, is to provide reliable information on the lakes you fish. The best way to do this is by keeping track of your fishing trips in an Angler's Diary. Please feel free to pick one up or contact the Minden office at 705-286-1521.

### **NOTICE – ANGLERS, HUNTERS & CAMPERS**

The Haliburton Highlands Water Trails respectfully requests that you comply with the following Backcountry Etiquette while visiting the water trails area. BE ADVISED that **CAMPING PERMITS** are now required from January 2<sup>nd</sup> through to December 18<sup>th</sup> annually for the Frost Centre and Poker Lakes Area. - Campsite Capacities...Campsites are individually posted, camp only on designated campsites.
- Garbage .....Pack it in; Pack it out, leave cans and bottles at home.
- Vegetation .....Do not cut, damage or remove live trees and/or shrubs.
- Privies .....Use privies provided or bury human waste at least 30m away from water.
- Cleansing Agents .....Use only biodegradable soaps, wash dishes on land.
- Portages .....Do not camp on portages or block other users.
- Bears .....Secure food and do not leave scraps in fire pits.
- Fires.....Consider fire hazards, collect firewood away from campsite, use a camp stove, extinguish fires with water, drown it out!
